The Pub is currently operating on a limited basis, and is for sale. It is a 2-story brick building, and has a rental garage apartment behind. There is a gravel off-street parking lot. The second floor and attic have been rented as apartments in the recent past. The purchase price includes the Pub's liquor license, as well as the bar equipment, coolers, etc.

This past Monday, a group of your officers toured the facility and met to discuss the pros and cons of the location. Location, security, and condition of the place were items we discussed. Also, since this would be a PURCHASE, and we would be the OWNERS, the question of being able to operate strictly as an AOH Hall and still pay the mortgage and expenses was addressed.

After all the discussion, we voted to send it to you Brothers, to review, question, and decide if your Officers

should proceed to make an offer on behalf of the Division. We have Building Funds monies that could be applied to the down-payment. To help you in your decision-making, please take a drive past the Pub, at 274 Innis, between South High and Parsons. We will also arrange for an Open House for your review.

Make no mistake, the place will need some work (cleaning, painting, etc), but for the most part, it appears to be cosmetic. We would be able to have our meetings in private, and improve the place as we go along.

We will discuss this further at the July meeting, so please take the time to check out the Village Pub, and bring us your questions, concerns and suggestions. It's all up to you!

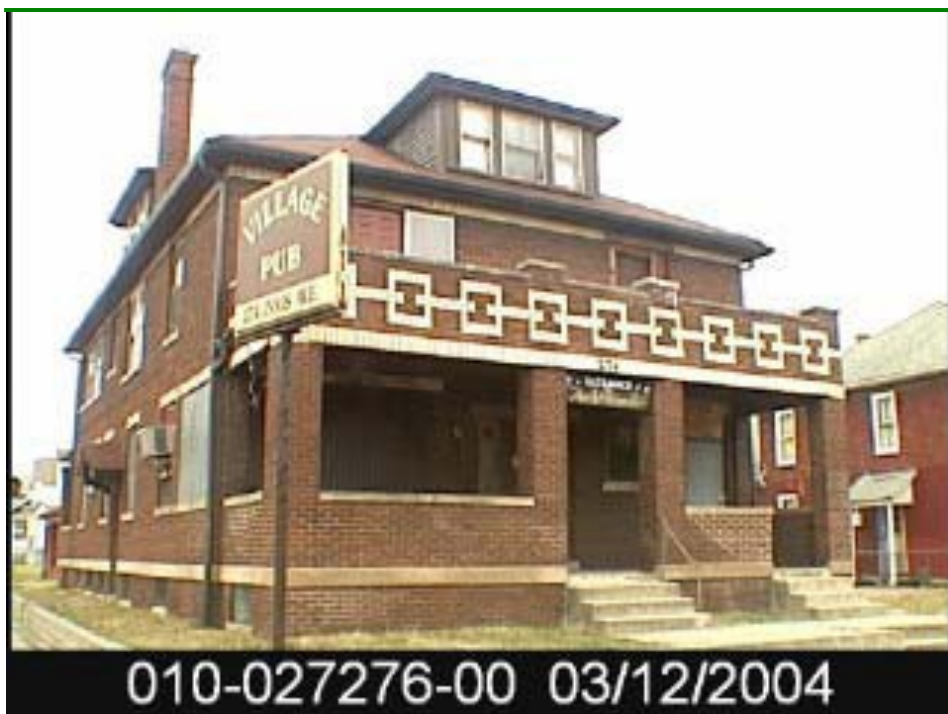

Each raffle ticket is \$10 and this helps fund the hospitality room at the National Convention. Contact Ron Hagan for tickets or come to the meeting on July 13th.

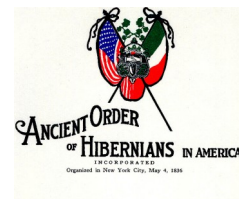
2008 AOH Apparel
